### **VBS/Church Family Mission Project**

70 million people worldwide need wheelchairs because of land mines, accidents, diseases like polio and leprosy, birth defects, etc.; many of them in places where roads are very rugged or non-existent. Since 1994 Mobility Worldwide (formerly PET International) has enabled more than 60,000 adults and children to avoid crawling on the ground or having to be carried by providing Mobility Carts: sturdy, 3-wheeled, hand-cranked vehicles.

In addition to mobility, the carts are providing dignity, freedom, opportunity to obtain an education, to earn a living - hope! - in more than 100 developing countries. The carts are built by volunteers and provided without cost! (The \$300 that it costs to build and ship each cart is supplied by compassionate donors).

Last summer, with your help, the VBS children were excited to be able to supply **three child-sized carts** to needy children. If you are able to help us again, we will surely appreciate your support. Thanks! *Karen Disegna*
