**Scam alert from the June 8, 2009 Manistee Area Chamber of Commerce newsletter:** "The phone rings, you pick it up, and the caller identifies himself as an officer of the court. He says you failed to report for jury duty and that a warrant is out for your arrest. You say you never received a notice. To clear it up, the caller says he'll need some information for 'verification purposes' - your birthdate, social security number, maybe even a credit card number. This is when you should hang up the phone. *It's a scam.*" Protect yourself! *Never* give out personal information when you receive an unsolicited phone call. Jury scams and other scams have seen a resurgence in recent months.
