Your church supports local, national and international mission projects. The national mission trip takes place each October. This year a group of twelve missionaries from our church will travel to **Frakes, Kentucky**. The project is to replace dangerous decks on a home for an elderly couple. The cost will be \$2500.00. We need your help with this project. In June there will be an offering plate in the back of the sanctuary for your contribution. We would appreciate your help. Thank you.

John and Diane Sonefeld invite their church family to **Bethany's graduation open house today** from 1:00 to 4:00 pm. Location is at the Sonefeld home, 4390 W. 1st Street, Ludington. Turn south on Meyers Road from US-30 (by Goodwill), then 1/2 mile down, turn left on 1st Street. They are almost at the end of the road on the left hand side...the double dome house. All are welcome for food and fellowship!

Today a group of eight, of which five are members of our church, will travel to **Haiti** on a **mission trip**. Those five are Bob Neal, Nate Carrier, Rommie MacDonald, and Dave and Bev Hamman. Others going are Tracy Neal (Bob's daughter), Natascha Hamman (Dave and Bev's sixteen-year-old granddaughter from Texas), and Suzanne Hutchinson from Brighton United Methodist Church. We fly out early tomorrow morning from Detroit and arrive in Port-au-Prince that afternoon.

Our plans are to visit the Methodist Children's Orphanage in Port-au-Prince the day after we arrive. Then we'll fly 60 miles north to Cap Haitien where we will spend the next seven days. Our church is sponsoring Baudin Elementary School just outside Cap Haitien. We plan on putting a new roof on the school; backfilling buildings with crushed stone; repairing the Baudin Methodist Church roof; and installing a volleyball court and a basketball backboard, rim and net. We also will conduct a Vacation Bible School and serve hot lunches to the schoolchildren. The last day and a half, we'll be back in Port-au-Prince visiting a hospital, school and orphanage, and putting up a volleyball court at the school. We leave Haiti on June 17 and arrive in Detroit late, so will spend the night in Detroit; arriving home on the 18th.
